

¿Qué \_\_\_\_\_ es?

To Answer:

\***Always** starts with "son las" unless it is 1:00, Midnight, Noon.

\*Starts with \_\_\_\_\_ if it is 1:00, Midnight, Noon.

\*If the time is an even hour (2:00, 5:00, 7:00) then it ends with \_\_\_\_\_

\*If it is in the \_\_\_\_\_ then it should be labeled "de la mañana".

\*If it is in the \_\_\_\_\_ then it should be labeled "de la tarde".

\*If it is in the \_\_\_\_\_ then it should be labeled "de la noche".

**Answering Process: (If it is 30 after or LESS)**

- 1.) If it is ANY time other than 1, midnight, noon... Write down \_\_\_\_\_.
- 2.) Decide what the hour is (short hand) and write it down.
- 3.) Write down the letter "y" between the numbers.
- 4.) Decide what the minutes are (long hand) and write them down.
- 5.) Write down the time of day (de la mañana= morning, de la tarde=afternoon, de la noche= evening)

(In the morning)

Ie: Son las once y cinco de la mañana.

(1) (2) (3) (4) (5)

**Answering Process: (If it is MORE than 30 after)**

- 1.) If it is ANY time other than 1, midnight, noon... Write down \_\_\_\_\_.
- 2.) Decide what the hour is (short hand) and add one hour to that number.
- 3.) Write down the word "menos".
- 4.) Subtract the minutes from 60 and write that number down (ie: 40 after:  $60-40=20$  write down 20)
- 5.) Write down the time of day (de la mañana= morning, de la tarde=afternoon, de la noche= evening)

3:50 in the afternoon

Ie: Son las cuatro **menos** diez de la tarde.

SPECIAL CASES:

If it is **Quarter after** (15 after) you should use the term *CUARTO*.

If it is **Quarter to** (45 after, 15 before) you should use *MENOS CUARTO*.

If it is **Thirty after** (30) you should use the term *MEDIA*.

If it is **MIDNIGHT** you should use *MEDIANOCHE*.

If it is **NOON** you should use *MEDIODÍA*
